Contest Information

Bus (Truck) Drop Off-Parking:

Please have buses and trucks drop off in front of the Performing Arts Center. If you are bringing large percussion instruments, please let Marc Telles know prior to the contest so we can make arrangements for you to unload in the PAC.

Instrument Cases:

Try to keep instrument cases on buses or trucks. There is limited storage for instrument cases in the Performing Arts Center area.

Warm-Up in Auxiliary Band Hall:

Per Mr. Harrell, your warm up time includes your entrance and exit time. Time does not start when you play your first note. Please be sure to be out of the room by your end time. Please bring your own tuner(s) and other technology.

Contest Office:

Upon arrival, please report to the contest office. You must submit 3 sets of **original scores**, 2 copies of your seating chart, and one announcer script plus any other documents required by the UIL Executive Secretary. Please do not email them.

Stage Equipment Available:

The following equipment will be available on stage upon request (aside from chairs/stands)

Director Podium, Director Stand, Piano (please let us know by March 1, 2023 if a piano is needed)

Percussion:

Timpani (32", 29", 26", 23", 20"), Bass Drum, Xylophone, Bells, Vibes, 4 1/3 Marimba, Gong, Chimes. Please bring all Percussion/Equipment not provided by Seguin ISD.

Sight-Reading Information:

Please note we are on the SR pilot program. Please scan the QR code for information from UIL.

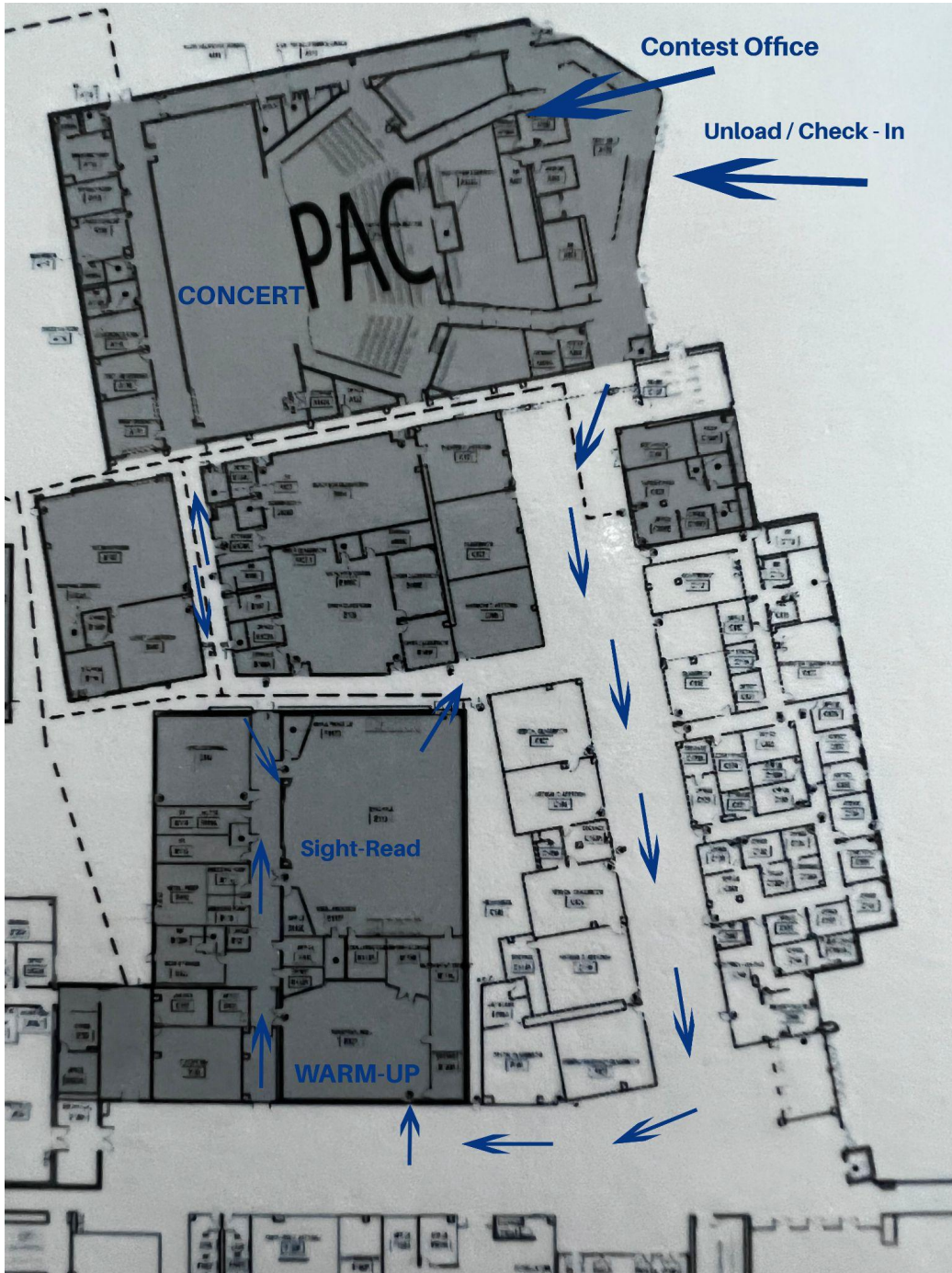


Other Information:

Maps






Clear Bag Policy
